We are so deeply honored to update you with all that has been happening in our family and the ministry at New City Church. Before we get into it...let us first say that none of this could have happened without your sacrifice and the step of faith you have taken to invest into this **ministry and our family**. A big part of my heart coming to New City was to bring support to the pastors there. I love the thought that as I supported them, I could feel you guys supporting me. I continually thank God for your generous hearts. Our pastors do too! God has been so faithful to us, and with your support, we have been able to try new things & be encouraged in seeing the gospel go out from our church family.



## Here are the highlights!

- We witnessed 10 baptisms and 10 child dedications this last year!
- We kicked off last summer by coming together in small gatherings called Meetups. MeetUps are fun events around the city that create opportunities for people to connect, belong, and be known. They were so successful that we are hosting them again this summer as I write this update!
- We launched small home groups called City Groups this past fall. City Groups help center our community life on the gospel and connection with God. We do this by joining around a meal and growing through study, discussion & prayer together. We were amazed at the eagerness there was to be family together. Our groups filled up so fast and filled to the brim! We hope this coming fall to add more groups so everyone has a place to be together.
- We started hosting a two day event in our home called "The Story of God" for people to connect with God and to help them better understand how the Bible was written as one beautiful story

**pointing to Jesus.** We look forward to hosting these a few times each year at our house. We have hosted three so far and our next one is this fall.

- We successfully met at the bay for over a year and towards the end of 2021 we were miraculously given an opportunity to transition our gatherings to a building through a local church in the Normal Heights neighborhood. Love when churches help churches!
- Meeting at a building brought amazing volunteer teams & leaders. It felt good to be working alongside each other to create a space for people to come hear the good news and celebrate on a weekly basis because of this good news!
- Trevor & Anja headed to Tijuana, Mexico at the end of May with a group from our church to build a home for a family through Amor Ministries. Amor Ministries has been dedicated to keeping families together who couldn't afford to provide for basic needs. Parents can spend less money on rent, and more on their children's education. We hope to do more trips there on a continual basis.
- We launched a yearly Bible reading plan as a church called "Seeing Jesus Together."
